Jenny later founded *Charm and Luck*, an accessories brand that found success worldwide, and co-founded *Artists and Company*, an agency representing photographers, stylists, influencers, and makeup artists, in partnership with the legendary agent Jed Root.

TRIT is Jenny's most personal project yet. Inspired by her grandmother's charm bracelets—where each charm tells a story—Jenny created TRIT to bring the same emotional resonance to fine jewelry. The TouchDate Technique transforms meaningful dates into tactile symbols, allowing wearers to feel their most cherished moments through the jewelry itself.

For Jenny, TRIT is about carrying your personal history with you, in a way that only you can feel. Away from the drawing board and office, Jenny loves spending time with her family, taking long walks with her dog Arne, and baking.
